Curbside Garbage

Pick ups are between 6:00AM and 6:00PM.



Sometimes our routes change, especially following holidays or due to inclement weather. As a result, garbage should be to the road no later than 6:00 AM on your scheduled pickup day.

If we have passed your residence and trash is not out, we will not come back!



All garbage **MUST** be bagged and securely tied, even if using garbage cans. Loose/untied garbage Will NOT be picked up.

Please make tied handles accessible to our workers, upside down bags are difficult to pull out of cans without tearing. If bags are ripped open due to animals, **it is YOUR responsibility to re-bag** the loose garbage.

Contact the office for pricing on bulk items. We will not pick up extra bags or bulk items unless prior arrangements are made. **We cannot accommodate you if you call day of.**

Unacceptable Curbside Items:

Appliances, electronics, batteries, flammables, hazardous waste, pesticides, tires, fluorescent bulbs, liquid paint/stain, medical waste, animal waste, human waste.

Weekly Service

High Volume: 8- 30 gal bags
Low Volume: 4- 30 gal bags
Extra Low Volume: 2- 30 gal bags
*Bags over your limit are \$2.50 PER BAG

- 13 gallon bags should weigh less than 25 lbs.
- 30 gallon bags should weigh less than 50 lbs.
- Contractor bags will now count as 2 bags.

Recycling

Recycling is picked up **once a month** (unless you have been informed otherwise by our office) and coincides with your first garbage pickup of the month.

You may bring recyclables to us if monthly pickup is not convenient for you.

Recycling is picked up by separate trucks and not at the same time as garbage. Make sure that your garbage and recycling are clearly separated. Recycling should be in a clear bag or receptacle that can be looked into and easily dumped. If using a large trash tote

for recycling, please bag your recycling, a full tote is too heavy to lift and dump.

PLEASE NOTE:

- We cannot recycle glass.
- Styrofoam and plastic wrap are not recyclable.
- Food containers must be rinsed out. Pizza boxes must be empty.
- Soiled recycling will be left behind.

Billing

Invoices are sent out quarterly and due upon receipt. Late fees are added after 30 days. Suspensions are implemented after 40 days. Terminations happen after 60 days. Once service has been terminated, there will be a \$10 restart fee if you wish to reinstate services.

1st Q — Sent 12/01 — Due by 1/01

2nd Q — Sent 3/01 — Due by 4/01

3rd Q — Sent 6/01 — Due by 7/01

4th Q — Sent 9/01 — Due by 10/01

We accept cash, checks and credit cards. Please include the invoice number on your check and retain the invoice for your records.

There is a \$3.00 convenience fee for using a credit card over the phone.

We also offer on-line bill pay, as well as automatic payments. If you wish to sign up for automatic payments, please contact the office or download the form at www.mrcny.com.

Canceling or Suspending Services

If you wish to cancel service, you **MUST** contact the office ahead of time. If you call after the fact, you will be charged for the weeks we still came to your address.

If you are a seasonal customer, you may suspend your service once in a 12 month period.
